Our Auditors have identified this as an area of risk, and consequently we are aiming to have 3 or 4 of the team fully trained in the MAGIQ Financial Planning system."

The City of Gold Coast has committed to investing the required amount of time and resources to the project upfront, in order to achieve a more efficient and accurate planning process in the long-term.

"We're undertaking a very thorough and thoughtful process initially to make sure we fully understand the planning model and the data requirement," said Steven.
